## **The Fishing Report**

The 2008 overall fishing to date has been slower than

normal but more consistent. Big walleyes are being caught more frequently this year. Some days are great while others are slower, however everyone seems to be coming back in with some fish everyday. Bass fishing is not bad with some large smallies being caught. A few muskies have been caught to date with the biggest one measuring at 48". Some decent Northern's have been brought in around the 30" mark. Several factors are responsible for the somewhat different fishing success this year. These include the water levels and temperature. I will elaborate on this in the Lake Condition topic.

## Lake Condition

The water temperature is still in the low to mid seventies. Typical temperature for this time of the year

is in the high 70's to low 80's. The lake water level is about 16" above normal as a result of a lot of rain throughout the month. The weed growth is somewhat normal in some areas of the lake and not apparent yet in other areas. The water is still fairly clear.

## Weather Update

Looks like July resembled June with a little less rain. The average temperature is lower than normal with no great heat waves in sight. Not much beach weather so far this year.

## What's New?

We've received our draft approval for our lot development. Our next step is for a professional assessor to come in and give us a

clear insight on the feasibility of the entire project. We need to assure ourselves that the development is a successful one. In addition, we have solicited the help of an archeologist to come in and do a archeological assessment of the area of concern. This is required as a condition to our draft approval.
